He was sentenced to state prison for the term prescribed by law for robbery. The appeal is a verbatim transcript of the record of the probation officer as augmented by a stipulated supplemental record. *154 Defendant contends his conviction should be set aside because he was not properly arraigned. The transcript contains a minute order which states, "Defendant in custody of jailer and his counsel thereto announced ready." (1) However, the record also contains a "Notice of Intention to Proceed Without Counsel" filed and signed by defendant. This notice contains the usual statement of defendant's intention to represent himself, his understanding of the consequences of his action, and his willingness to abide by the rules of the court. Under such circumstances a complete record was made of the arraignment. (People v. Jackson (1964) 228 Cal. App.2d 621, 625 [39 Cal. Rptr. 719]; People v. Louis (1965) 233 Cal.
